Governing Board Approved Safety and Security Policies and Procedures

Governing board-approved policies

- A. The school will make a reasonable attempt to notify the parent of a student before the student is removed from the school, school transportation, or a school sponsored activity to be taken to a receiving facility for an involuntary examination.
- B. The school students will be notified of threats, unlawful acts, and significant emergencies pursuant to s. 1006.07(4) and (7).
- C. Parents of Alpha International Academy students have a right to access school safety and discipline incidents as reported pursuant to s. 1006.07(9)



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- D. A safe-school officer shall be present, at a minimum, during the school day when the school facility is open for instruction, as defined by the school calendar.
- E. A safe-school officer will be assigned to the school facility for sporting events and extracurricular activities and when more than 50% of school population will be present.
- F. Alpha has adopted the districts threat assessment policies.

Governing board-approved procedures

- A. The designated school personnel will make a reasonable effort to contact the parent/guardian of the student via phone, text and or email prior to removing a student from school, school transportation or a school sponsored activity.
- B. The school designated personnel notify parents by our all-call system, text and email of any threats, unlawful acts, or significant emergencies.
- C. School will provide parents with their right to access school safety and discipline incidents via the code of student conduct, school newsletter and website annually.
- D. The school will hire or contract a safe-school officer to be present at the school during instructional time in accordance with the school calendar.
- E. A safe-school officer will be presence at extracurricular activity will be based on projected student attendance.
- F. Alpha has adopted the districts threat assessment procedures.
